

General conditions at the Veron Hamradio Convention effective 1 Jan 2020

Participants in the DvdRA: VROM, AMRATO, Commissions and associations, or DIY exhibition

Set-up: Friday from 12 a.m. - 8 p.m. with professional night surveillance (see registration form) or Saturdays from 7 a.m. - 9:30 p.m. The hall is open to the public on Saturday from 9:30 AM to 5:00 PM. You can even bring your own chairs and extension cable.

Definitions

- Organization and organizer are the Veron events committee
- Participant is the person or company that rents a stand at the Veron Hamradio convention

Participants undertake without reservation:

1. Instructions and regulations of employees of the IJsselhallen; the fire brigade and other authorized persons who are also part of the organization must be followed immediately upon demand. The Veron organizers can be recognized by their green vest.
2. Participation is at and at your own risk, with the exclusion of and indemnification for the organizer and on behalf of his acting persons for any liability. Also, for all damages that are directly or indirectly the result of facts, circumstances, actions or behaviors that may occur to a participant in the context of his participation.
3. The participant must be sufficiently insured against any form of legal liability that may arise between the participant (s), organizer and visitors to the stand (s) rented by the participant.
4. The organization cannot be held liable in the case of damage mentioned in points 2 and 3 of this condition.
5. The participant must not vacate their stands before 4 pm on the Veron Hamradio convention. If due to special circumstances earlier evacuation is necessary, this will be discussed with the organizer in advance.
6. The participant undertakes the necessary measures to minimize the chance of theft of his goods and or means of transport.
7. In order to acquire one or more stands, you must register and register in accordance with the indicated procedure, in this case complete the registration form and be paid no later than the stated date.
8. The participant is not permitted to rent out stand space that has been allocated to him, whether or not against payment, under or through or to transfer it to third parties. If, for whatever reason, you cannot or do not want to use the rented space that has been allocated to you, you must immediately report this to the organization.
9. Deregistering after you have registered can be done no later than 2 weeks before the start of the Veron Hamradio convention. You will receive half amount paid back after deduction of administration costs. The amount only concerns the costs of the stand, not of any additional cost. If you cancel less than 2 weeks before Veron Hamradio convention, payment to the organization will be canceled.

10. All waste during and after the end of Veron Hamradio convention must be disposed of by the participant at his own expense. Residual waste that can be attributed to the participant will be invoiced afterwards and paid for immediately by the participant.

11. Only electronics and electronics related products may be sold on Veron Hamradio convention. These products are preferably aimed at communication, technology or aids, for example measuring equipment, tools or antennas, etc. Definitely no toys or products that can be assumed not to be related to the purpose of Veron Hamradio convention. In case of doubt, contact the organization.

12. It is not permitted to offer or use highly flammable products, unless the organization has explicitly requested and been granted permission in advance. This also includes covering agents demonstrably have undergone fire-retardant treatment and have been approved for this.

13. In and exits must remain free for assistance, during loading and unloading this can be temporarily and very briefly deviated from.

The main doors will be closed during the opening hours of the event.

14. Aisles must be and remain accessible freely and without obstacles. Any cables on the floor are permitted but sufficiently secured to guarantee unobstructed passage.

15. Participant also ensures that no sharp products protrude from the stand that could accidentally injure visitors. You must ensure that visitor safety is guaranteed at all times.

16. First aid is available and in case of an emergency contact the organization

17. Smoking is prohibited in all places for all visitors and participants in the IJsselhallen.

18. It is not permitted to hold a light or sound show on or at the rented space, this at the discretion of the organization.

19. By signing the registration form you have agreed to the aforementioned conditions without reservation. The organization reserves the right to exclude the exhibitor from further participation if the instructions of the organization are not be followed.
